

About Green Card Lottery Program

The Diversity Immigrant Visa program, also known as the Green Card Lottery, is an annual program run by the United States Department of State granting permanent residence visas to persons that meet the eligibility requirements. The objective of the Green Card Lottery is to help the United States of America maintain its reputation as a fusion of global culture.

Applicants for the Green Card Lottery are initially chosen through a random computer-generated lottery drawing. The visas are distributed among six geographic regions with a greater number of visas going to regions with lower rates of immigration. Each year 50,000 applicants will be granted the visas (green cards). The visa will entitle you to live and work in the United States of America. You will also be permitted to bring your spouse and any unmarried children under the age of 21 to the United States of America. Once selected in the lottery, you will be notified by mail and provided with further instruction for your immigration processing.

Application Requirements

- You must be a native of a eligible country,

AND

- You must possess at least a high school education or its equivalent, OR, you have 2 years of work experience, within the last 5 years, in an occupation requiring at least 2 years training or experience

Eligible Countries:

All countries in the world are eligible countries **EXCEPT** for the following countries: **Canada, China (mainland born), Colombia, Dominican Republic, El Salvador, Haiti, India, Jamaica, Mexico, Pakistan, Philippines, South Korea, United Kingdom and it's dependent territories, Vietnam.** (Hong Kong SAR, Macau SAR, Taiwan and Northern Ireland are eligible)

If you were born in one of the ineligible countries listed above, you may still qualify to apply if you meet one of the following two conditions:

- 1) If spouse was born in an eligible country, that person can claim the spouse's country of birth under the condition that both applicant and spouse are issued visas and enter the U.S.A at the same time.
- 2) If you were born in a country of which neither parent was a native, such person may be able to claim nativity in one of the parents' country of birth.

How To Apply

1. Complete and Sign Application Form

Please fill up the application form attached, using blue or black pen. Please write carefully and legibly. Use additional forms if you have more than 3 children. Remember to sign on the forms!

2. Include Photograph (s)

Please attach photographs for the applicant, the spouse and each of the children. Make sure that all your photos are between 1.5 x 1.5 and 2 x 2 (inches) in size. Please write the names and dates of birth on the back of the photo.

3. Include Payment

Please include the appropriate payment, payable to "**E M A International**".

Frequently Asked Questions

1) What is a Green Card?

It is a US permanent residence visa. It allows you to live and work permanently and legally in the United States.

2) What is a Green Card Lottery?

Please refer to Page 1.

3) Am I eligible for this lottery?

Please check the requirements on Page 1.

4) How will the winners be selected?

All applications received will be separated into one of six geographic regions and individually numbered. After the end of the application period, a computer will randomly select entries from among all the mail received for each geographic region. Within each region, the first letter randomly selected will be the first case registered, the second letter selected the second registration, etc.

All entries received will have an equal chance of being selected within each region. When an entry has been selected, the applicant will be sent a notification letter by the US State Department, which will provide visa application instructions. The US State Department will continue to process the case until those who are selected are instructed to appear for their visa interviews at a U.S. consular office or until those able to do so apply at an INS office in the United States for change of status.

5) Will applicants who are not selected be informed?

No, applicants who are not selected will receive no response to their entry. Only those who are selected will be informed.

6) May persons who are already registered for an immigrant visa in another category apply for the lottery?

Yes, such persons may apply for the lottery through this registration as well.

7) Can I submit more than one application per lottery?

No, the law allows only one entry for each person during each registration period; applicants who submit more than one entry during each registration period will be disqualified. Even though you have submitted applications for previous registration periods, you can still apply for the current registration period.

However, **a husband and wife may each submit separate applications** but pay only one processing fee (this includes husband, wife and children, if any). **Choosing the Family Package doubles your chances of being selected** a winner in the lottery. If you are applying for the Family Package, each spouse must meet the lottery eligibility requirements. Two separate applications should be completed, one for each spouse. One application should be signed by one

spouse, and the other application should be signed by the other spouse. Each application must include the other spouse and all unmarried children under 21 years of age. Both applications should be mailed to us in one envelope, with two passport size photographs for each family member, and the processing fee.

8) What family members must I include in my application?

You must list your spouse, and all children who are unmarried and under the age of 21. You must list your spouse even if you are currently separated from him/her. However, if you are formally divorced, you do not need to list your former spouse. For customary marriages, the important date is the date of the original marriage ceremony, not the date on which the marriage is registered.

You must list ALL your unmarried children under age 21, whether they are your natural children, your spouse's children by a previous marriage, or children you have formally adopted in accordance with the laws of your country. Even children in the above categories not currently living with you must be listed on the entry.

The fact that you have listed family members on your entry does not mean that they later must travel with you. They may choose to remain behind. However, if you include an eligible dependent on your visa application forms whom you failed to include on your original entry, your case will be disqualified. (This only applies to persons who were dependents at the time the original application was submitted, not those acquired at a later date.) Listing ineligible persons (a brother or sister, a child over 21, a child living with you but not formally adopted, etc.) on your entry will not disqualify the entry, but it will not make such persons eligible for a visa.

Your spouse may still submit a separate entry, even though he or she is listed on your entry, as long as both entries include details on all dependents in your family. Therefore choosing the Family Package doubles your chances of winning.
